The new 15,000-square-foot facility offers a versatile layout, including an auditorium that can accommodate up to 80 students and two 24-seat classrooms.

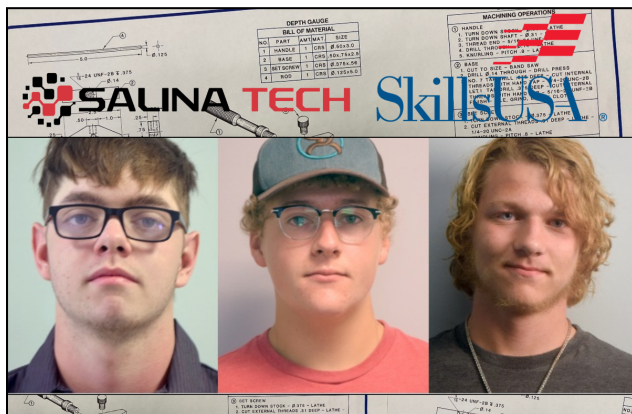
Salina Tech's Industrial Maintenance and Automation program, launching in 2024, is designed from the ground up with the needs of local manufacturing companies in mind. Major employers are increasingly turning to automated systems as part of their production process, and this program teaches the skills needed to set up, configure, and maintain these complex systems. The IMA Program wing of the new facility will feature a large shop, classrooms, and offices.



Students and Alumni participated in the first Build My Future Salina, held at Tony's Pizza Event Center, filling the Great Plains Manufacturing Convention Hall and parking lots. The day-long, hands-on event aimed to inspire youth to pursue professional careers in the skilled trades and building industry. Nearly 300 high school students from North Central Kansas high schools participated.

In 2019, the first Practical Nursing (PN) class graduated 28 students; this year's PN class graduated 29 students. In 2020, our first registered nurse (RN) class graduated 14 students; this year's RN class graduated 23.
